Child Find

Child Find is a component of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) that requires school districts to locate, identify, and evaluate children ages three to twenty-one who have a suspected disability and may be in need of special education services. It is a continuous process of public awareness activities, screenings and evaluations to locate, identify, and refer children as early as possible.

Caregivers who may have con-



cerns about a child's development in one or more of the following areas: vision and hearing, speech and

language, cognitive, motor, adaptive, and social skills may contact the Child Find office for an appointment.

WHY DOES MY CHILD NEED A SCREENING?



Screenings help identify delays in developmental milestones in preschool children. They address academics, speech and language and/or social behaviors in school children. Screenings help determine if a child needs an evaluation for a suspected disability and may be in need of special education services.



Child Find Screening Appointment

Screenings are for children ages 2 ½ years and older who reside in Marion County and **are not** enrolled in public school. Students who attend private schools, homeschools, and day care centers are eligible to receive screenings.

We will complete a vision and hearing, a speech and language, and a developmental screening with your child at your appointment.
